

Good Standing Process



The *Good Standing Policy* aims to reinforce Newton Moore Senior High School's values and *Student Behaviour Expectations*. It also aims to teach and assist students to take responsibility for their behaviour, make positive choices and encourage them to do well in all areas of schooling. At NMSHS every student will begin the school year with **Good Standing**. This entitles the student to all school privileges.

Requirements for maintaining Good Standing

Students who lose their Good Standing will not be allowed to attend extracurricular incursions/excursions, reward activities, inter-school sport or similar for a period of five weeks from the loss of Good Standing. Parents/Guardians and Year Coordinators will be notified and it will be recorded on SIS. Students who lose their Good Standing will not miss out on activities which are 'whole school events' or required for assessment purposes.
