| Completion | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Complete at least 20 units, including at least three two-unit combinations• Up to 50 per cent can be endorsed programs• Completion of a full-year D or E code subject will equate to two course units• Complete four units from an English course. |
| Achievement Standard | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Achieve an average of a C grade or better across 10 course units from at least five courses/subject equivalents (at least three two-unit combinations must be included)• Achievement of an industry specific VET course unit equates to a C grade• Up to 10 unit equivalents of endorsed programs can be included to reduce this load to six course units from three courses (endorsed programs do not count toward the C grade average) |
| English language competence | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Meet the English language competence standard, as defined by work samples. |
| Breadth of study | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Complete at least one course from List A and at least one course from List B in the final year of school</u> |
| Examinations | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• WACE courses: All students in their final year who are enrolled in a pair of units at Stage 2 or 3 sit the exam (unless exempt) |
