

STUDENT DRIVERS

Policy ...

Students wishing to drive a vehicle (car, motorcycle, scooter, etc) to school must apply in writing, using the appropriate form.

In so applying, students and their parents accept the rules and guidelines set out below.

Rationale ...

The policy recognises the desire of licensed students to drive to school, as well as the associated convenience. It facilitates regular driving practice for the new driver, but within strict guidelines.

Guidelines ...

- Application Forms are available from the Student Services Program Coordinator.
- The vehicle is to be used only to transport the student to school in the morning and home in the afternoon.
- Students may not go to vehicles between 8.40am and 3.10pm.
- The vehicle is not to be used to transport any other student(s) except as included in the Application Form.
- Vehicles are to be parked only in the student parking area at the south-east corner of the school oval. A scooter park is provided near the Caretaker's House. NOTE: No responsibility is taken for vehicle security, nor does any insurance cover exist.
- Students with a Lunch Pass may drive home for lunch (not to nearby shops or elsewhere).
- A registered student driver may use his or her vehicle during the school day only where a Deputy Principal authorises it and a parent / guardian gives written permission.
- **Failure to comply with these guidelines will lead to cancellation of the Permit.**
